The class attendance again was from 20-23 students 3rd and 4th grade. The larger the class the more time is needed, just so we can move slow and give them more time to take in information. Judging from some of the survey answers, understanding of English was one of the challenges. One of the students did not want to use her book that was in Spanish. I thought that was great because at the end of the class she was very thankful and attempting to ask question in English. I would like to spend more time on the post questions to make sure they understand (looking at # 6 for example).

Again as I listened to the children in the classroom, we know that from their conversations some of the information was being absorbed. Such things as counting money sharing and investing were the words that they used.
